1. Site access & set up begins at 7:00 AM until 9:00 AM. All vendors should be set up and ready to sell by 9:00 AM.
2. Vendors must provide their own tables and chairs; limited number of picnic tables available under the pavilion.
3. All materials, sale items and trash must be removed by vendor upon leaving.
4. Follow the directions below; go to the SCA table set up under the pavilion to sign-in and get your space location.
5. **PLEASE** bring this form with you on Canal Day; it is your **entry pass**.
6. Electric is available; please bring your own extension cords.
7. Restrooms & food concessions will be available.
8. Canal Day activities include food, live music, water sport competitions, kid's games and crafts and many other events throughout the day.
9. We will make every effort to ensure that your experience will be enjoyable.

Directions:

From Rt. 422 E or W – Collegetown exit to Rt. 29 South (Collegetown Road). Follow Rt. 29S for 3 miles. Go through flashing yellow light at Egypt Rd. and at the next traffic light (Jacobs & Bridge Sts.) make a right and follow Jacobs St. to St. Michael's Park entrance.

From Rt. 29 N – turn left onto Jacobs Street at the first traffic light after crossing the Schuylkill River from Phoenixville. Follow Jacobs St. to St. Michael's Park entrance.
