Volunteers should meet at Lock 60 in Mont Clare by 9:00 AM, sign in at the Locktender's House, be given an assignment and necessary tools and materials

and then go from there. All that volunteers will need to bring along is the willingness to work; gloves, trash bags and all other materials will be provided by SCA.

Let's all gather together to make our little piece of Mother Earth much more beautiful. Come to volunteer an hour or two, or stay for the entire day and afterwards enjoy lunch with other volunteers.
